When this step has been completed, all of the parts are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Certain components like for example crankshafts, cylinder blocks, connecting rods and cylinder heads are resized, reground and resurfaced if needed. Several parts like for instance gears, nuts, bolts et cetera. are replaced or repaired as needed.
